2021 Virtual Season Rules

1.0 Eligibility

1.1 An official entry per video submission must be submitted and paid in full prior to the entry deadline date. Entry fees are non-refundable.

1.2 MAPS/WGI require all participating groups to comply with US Copyright Law regarding performance and/ or use of arrangements of copyrighted music, visual images and other materials, as well as the use of copyrighted audio, spoken text and display of copyrighted words and images.

1.5 Performer age limits - by division, and class - MAPS will follow the Official WGI 2020 Rules, and includes the COVID Extended Eligibility clause. *The WGI Board of Directors extend the eligibility for one year only, during the 2021 competitive season, for performers who were members of independent units as of March 11, 2020.*

- 4.1 All WGI rules from the 2020 competitive season apply, unless otherwise noted in this document

7.0 Video Procedure

	Viewpoint should be from an elevated perspective. No zooming or moving the camera

You will be required to upload your video for each event separately via Comp Suite.	You will be required to upload your video for each event separately via Comp Suite. Use of a more recent video performance for each contest is allowed but not required
All videos must be submitted by submission date for evaluation.	All videos must be uploaded by the submission date or the entry will be disqualified
The program must own the right to the video. (recorded it yourself)	The program must own right to the video (recorded it yourself)

8.1 Feedback will be offered by 2 evaluators via Competition Suite

8.2 Complete evaluation process will be released as soon as WGI releases it

8.3 Videos will be submitted via Competition Suite. M.A.P.S. will not post the videos publicly

9.0 Disqualification

9.1 Any participant that does not adhere to the terms and procedures of these Rules and Regulations, submits inappropriate content/music, submits paperwork on time or does not submit their video before the deadline will be subject to disqualification from the competition and will automatically forfeit entry fees and any rights to awards

12.0 Fees/ Registration Process

12.1 All registration and video submissions will be done through competition suite.

Competition Suite utilizes “Stripe” for payments. Similar to “PayPal”.

12.2 **I&E** will be offered virtually. \$8.00 per participant regardless of individual or ensemble. This will be done via stripe through competition suite.
